The hospital assesses the patient's healthrelated social needs and provides information about community resources and support services.

Note 1: Hospitals determine which healthrelated social needs to include in the patient assessment. Examples of a patient's healthrelated social needs may include access to transportation, difficulty paying for prescriptions or medical bills, education and literacy, food insecurity and housing insecurity.

Note 2: Health-related social needs may be identified for a representative sample of patients or for all patients.
